The tribal village of Kevadia is home to the Sardar Sarovar Dam built on the Narmada river and was a popular picnic spot even before the Statue of Unity came up. Nestled between the Satpura and Vindhya mountain ranges, the gigantic statue of Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, built in 2018 The Statue of Unity is a colossal statue of Indian statesman and the Ironman of India Sardar Vallabhbhai The 'Kevadia Tourism Circuit'. The circuit covers 35 tourist places in Kevadiya, out of which the Valley of Flowers, Vishwa Van, Jungle Safari, Cactus Garden, Butterfly Garden, Ekta Nursery, and River Rafting.
